Dear Parishioners,

The month of October is the month of the Holy Rosary. The Rosary is a way of contemplating the whole life of Jesus Christ and entering into the mystery of his divine life; the life where death was transformed into life, hatred into love, despair into hope, division into unity, confusion into understanding and defeat into victory.

St. Bernard, teaches that with Mary's "fiat" (YES) the world undergoes a re-creation through the graces of the Incarnation - a re-creation that is still in process until the Second Coming of Jesus. Mary's cooperation with the Will of God and her response of total submission to that Will with her fiat - "*I am the handmaid of the Lord be it done to me according to thy word*" allows for the Redemption of not just humanity but of all Creation.

Since Mary is rightly to be regarded as the way by which we are led to Christ, the person who encounters Mary cannot but encounter Christ likewise. Mary leads us to Christ who is God made man. We honour Mary but we worship Christ. For what other reason do we continually turn to Mary except to seek the Christ in her arms, to seek our Saviour in her, through her, and with her! Whenever we cover the 20 decades of the Rosary, we would have contemplated the four gospels and some of the books of the Bible.

I warmly encourage all to pray the Holy Rosary in our families and churches especially this month. All the very best and God bless.
