On Sunday, Jan 14, in the Church's Calendar, we begin what is called **ORDINARY TIME.**

Because the term *ordinary* in English most often means something that's not special or distinctive, many people think that Ordinary Time refers to parts of the calendar of the Catholic Church that are unimportant.

Even though the season of Ordinary Time makes up most of the liturgical year in the Catholic Church. Ordinary Time is called "ordinary" not because it is common but simply because the weeks of Ordinary Time are numbered. The Latin word *ordinalis*, which refers to numbers in a series, stems from the Latin word *ordo*, from which we get the English word *order*. Therefore, the numbered weeks of Ordinary Time, in fact, represent the ordered life of the Church's liturgy and the people of God.

The Second Sunday of Ordinary Time (*which is actually the first Sunday celebrated in Ordinary Time*) always features either John the Baptist's acknowledgment of Christ as the Lamb of God or Christ's first miracle—the transformation of water into wine at the wedding at Cana.

So, for Catholics, Ordinary Time is the part of the year in which Christ, the Lamb of God, walks among us and transforms our lives. There's nothing "ordinary" about that!
