PRAYER FOR AUSTRALIA



O Immaculate Mary, Help of Christians, Queen of heaven and earth, and tender Mother of humanity, we entrust to you our nation, Australia, and all who live in this country.

We commit to your intercession all the members of our community, beginning with the weakest ones, from the unborn to the sick, the disabled and the elderly.

We commit to you our families, our young and old, and all who are vulnerable.

At the heart of the mystery of the Holy Trinity is the belief that God is not isolated and alone but is, in some mysterious way, a communion of life and love.

The Scriptures teach us to speak of God as Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, and these names all point to the idea of relationships. Our belief in the Trinity teaches us that the Father, Son, and Spirit are the one God in their relationships of love and self-giving to each other.

What does this mean for us in our everyday lives? In the book of Genesis, we learn that God has created human beings in the divine image and likeness. For the Jewish people, God is one, as he is for Muslims and for us. However, no other religion has ever understood that this one God is a communion of love. The world had to wait for Jesus for this to be made known. If we are created in the image of God, then we are created in the image of a communion of love. This means that our vocation, our calling, is to live in relationships of love and self-giving, just as God lives in a relationship of mutual love and self-giving between the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. "God is love," says St. John, "and the person who lives in love lives in God."

The Most Holy Trinity Year B

First Reading

Deuteronomy 4:32-34. 39-40

A reading from the book of Deuteronomy

The Lord himself is God in heaven above and on earth below: there is no other.

Moses said to the people: 'Put this question to the ages that are past, that went before you, from the time God created man on earth: Was there ever a word so majestic, from one end of heaven to the other? Was anything ever heard? Did ever a people hear the voice of the living God speaking from the heart of the fire, as you heard it, and remain alive? Has any god ventured to take to himself one nation from the midst of another by ordeals, signs, wonders, war with mighty hand and outstretched arm, by fearsome terrors – all this that the Lord your God did for you before your eyes in Egypt? 'Understand this today, therefore, and take it to heart: The Lord is God indeed, in heaven above as on earth beneath, he and no other. Keep his laws and commandments as I give them to you today so that you and your children may prosper and live long in the land that the Lord your God gives you for ever.'

The spirit you received is not the spirit of slaves bringing fear into your lives again; it is the spirit of sons, and it makes us cry out, 'Abba, Father!' The Spirit himself and our spirit bear united witness that we are children of God. And if we are children we are heirs as well: heirs of God and coheirs with Christ, sharing his sufferings so as to share his glory.
