OUR LORD JESUS CHIRST, KING OF THE UNIVERSE

24th November 2024 YEAR B



The Solemnity of Christ the King is less than 100 years old. It was established by Pope Pius XI in 1925. People explained his reasons for this Solemnity in an encyclical letter called "Quas primas". "In the first". Pope instituted the Solemnity of Christ the King to remind the world that to reject Christ, either in private or public life, is to reject our only hope, and to accept him is to accept salvation. As Pope Pius XI wrote: "...When once men recognise, both in private and in public life, that Christ is King, society will at last receive the great blessings of real liberty, well-ordered discipline, peace and harmony... That these blessings may be abundant and lasting in Christian society, it is necessary that the kingship of our Savior should be as widely as possible recognised and understood.... (Quas primas, #19)

The Gospel we read this Sunday ends with Jesus' words, 'Yes, I am a king. I was born for this; I came into the world for this: to bear witness to the truth; and all who are on the side of truth listen to my voice.'

If Jesus came to witness, to testify to the truth, if he is the truth, if he is the king of truth, what would my loyalty to truth look like in confrontation with the ideologies that are overwhelmingly present these days?

The History of Our Lady of La Vang

Fearing the growth of Catholicism in Vietnam, Emperor Canh Thinh first restricted Catholicism in 1798. Soon, this turned into persecution. Fearing for their lives, many Catholics fled. A group of refugees hid in the forest of La' Vang in the Quang Tri Province. Every night, they gathered to pray the rosary. One night, as they gathered to pray the Rosary, they saw a beautiful woman dressed in traditional Vietnamese clothing, holding a baby in her arms. She appeared to them several times, comforting and encouraging them in their time of need. People recognised the woman as the Virgin Mary and began to venerate her as Our Lady of La Vang. They built a small shrine in her honour, and word of their sightings spread throughout the region. Soon, other Catholics began making pilgrimages to the jungle to pray at the shrine, seeking the intercession of Our Lady of La Vang for their own needs. Our Lady of La' Vang is the Patroness of Vietnam and all Vietnamese people. Her feast day is November 22.

Commemorating this Saturday, Our Lady of La Vang, and the witness of Vietnamese people to their Catholic faith, over 100,000 Vietnamese martyrs during 300 years sacrificed their lives for Christ and His Church. We entrust ourselves and the Vietnamese Community of our parish to the intercession of Our Lady of La Vang. Along with many parishioners from different ethnic backgrounds, the Vietnamese community enriches the Darra Jindalee Parish with their beautiful culture, spirituality, and their cuisine.

SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM
