OUR LORD JESUS CHRIST KING OF THE UNIVERSE 22nd November 2025 Year C



The Solemnity of Christ the King celebrates His power and authority through a collage of images that depict various aspects of His kingship. Each image offers a new interpretation of what it means to be a king, giving the concept fresh meaning. When combined, they form a kind of litany that praises Christ's kingship.

Think of Shepherd and Commander as symbols of Christ's loving care and guidance for those who follow him. The King of Israel reflects his universal kingship, showing that his rule extends beyond just one nation. The image of the Invisible God celebrates Christ's divine origin and his authority over all creation. Firstborn of all Creation highlights his supremacy over everything made, while Source of all Created Things emphasises both his sovereignty and his role as the perfect example for everything that exists.

As head of the Body, the Church, it reveals the close relationship between Christ and those who belong to him through faith and baptism. Firstborn of the Dead not only honours Christ's resurrection but also assures us that those who follow him will be resurrected too. Lastly, the crucified King beautifully interprets all other images, showing that his sacrifice is at the heart of his identity.

The entire liturgical year is brought to completion in the last words of the gospel: 'Today you will be with me in Paradise.' These are the words that we all long to hear, words that are empty when coming from one who has no authority but charged with power when spoken by the one who is king over us all.

First Reading

A reading from the second book of Samuel 5: 1-3

All the tribes of Israel came to David at Hebron. 'Look' they said 'we are your own flesh and blood. In days past when Saul was our king, it was you who led Israel in all their exploits; and the Lord said to you, "You are the man who shall be shepherd of my people Israel, you shall be the leader of Israel.'" So all the elders of Israel came to the king at Hebron, and King David made a pact with them at Hebron in the presence of the Lord, and they anointed David king of Israel.

A reading from the letter of St Paul to the Colossians 1:12-20

He is the image of the unseen God

A reading from the holy Gospel according Luke 23: 35-43

The people stayed there before the cross watching Jesus. As for the leaders, they jeered at him. 'He saved others,' they said, 'let him save himself if he is the Christ of God, the Chosen One.' The soldiers mocked him too, and when they approached to offer him vinegar they said, 'If you are the king of the Jews, save yourself.' Above him there was an inscription: 'This is the King of the Jews.'

One of the criminals hanging there abused him. 'Are you not the Christ?' he said. 'Save yourself and us as well.' But the other spoke up and rebuked him. 'Have you no fear of God at all?' he said. 'You got the same sentence as he did, but in our case we deserved it: we are paying for what we did. But this man has done nothing wrong. Jesus,' he said, 'remember me when you come into your kingdom.' 'Indeed, I promise you,' he replied, 'today you will be with me in paradise.'
