## THE MOST HOLY TRINITY SUNDAY 31ST May 2026



Today's Gospel recounts Jesus' night conversation with Nicodemus. Jesus explains the mystery of the Holy Trinity to Nicodemus, who was a Pharisee and an anonymous follower of Jesus.

The way of life and the preaching of the teacher of Nazareth attracted Nicodemus and convinced him that Jesus was sent by God. In the conversation, Jesus leads Nicodemus to grasp the content of his teaching when he speaks of spiritual and supernatural things. He wants to raise Nicodemus' natural thinking to the level of spiritual reality. In this way, Jesus speaks of the very essence of the Gospel message contained in the words: **"God so loved the world that he gave his only begotten Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life"** (v. 16).

Jesus reminds Nicodemus that God is first and foremost a Father, and only then a judge.

This Father loves not only Israel but also the entire corrupt, pagan, and broken human world. His love for the world motivates the Father to send his only Son for its salvation. Because of sin, the world is condemned and immersed in spiritual darkness, yet the Father wishes none to perish. That's why he sent his Son, so that the world might be saved through him. The Son was not sent to condemn but to heal humanity. Salvation, which grants access to eternal life, is received through faith in Jesus. Faith involves surrendering to the Holy Spirit's action, who first moves people to recognise God's revelation and commit their lives to Him.

Today, let us embrace the light of the Gospel brought to us through Jesus, who was sent by the Father to save the world from the darkness of sin, so that we may be born anew by the Holy Spirit and enter into new life.

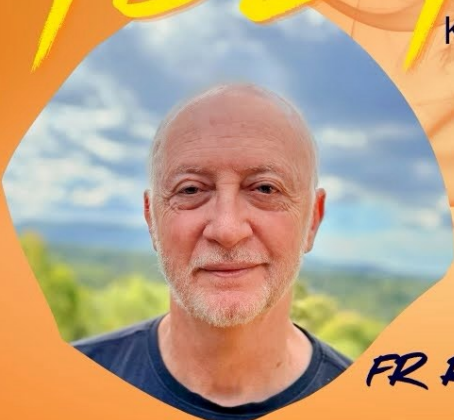

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**Corpus Christi Procession**



The Eucharistic Procession is a public expression of our belief in the real presence of our Lord in the Holy Eucharist. In our parish, we will declare this belief at Darra after **the 9 am Mass on Sunday, June 7.**

After Mass, we will process along Darra Station Rd, then turn right onto Lee St and again right onto Scott St. The Procession will terminate at the School grounds (the undercover area), where, after the benediction, we will have morning tea and refreshments. I encourage all parishioners to join us and walk together with the Lord along the local streets of our parish.

The Archdiocesan Corpus Christ Procession, "**Walk with Jesus,**" will be held **on Sunday, June 7.** Led by Archbishop Shane Mackinlay, the event will begin **at 2:00 pm at the Cathedral of St Stephen**, proceed through the Brisbane CBD, and conclude with Benediction.
